


Section A - Grammar

A sentence is a group of words that makes complete sense.

A sentence always begins with a capital letter.

A sentence usually has a full stop ... at the end.

Look at the following groups of words.

These groups of words do not make complete sense because the words in them are not placed in a proper order.

Read these groups of the same words again.

- The baby is crying.
- The cow has a tail.
- He sang a very sweet song.

Now each of these groups of words has a complete meaning as the words are arranged in a proper order.
