Sentence Formation

Children, you know that we express our ideas and feelings in words and sentences. Look at the following groups of words.

- ❖ He is the manager of a bank.
- ❖ What a nice place!
- ❖ Sameera drove her car.
- ❖ Shanu Menon is a scientist.
- ❖ Where are you going?
- ❖ How beautiful the rainbow is!

Each of these groups of words makes complete sense. Each group begins with a capital letter and ends with a full stop (.), an exclamation mark (!) or a question mark (?).

Hence, they are sentences.



A **sentence** is a group of words that makes complete sense.
